PROJET LOI 130 ARCHITECTURAL COMPETITION


The winner of the "Projet Loi 130" architectural competition, organised in Brussels by the European Commission, is a consortium of five companies specialised in architectural and engineering services: Team leader RAFAEL DE LA-HOZ ARQUITECTOS (Spain); Perkins + Will UK Limited (UK); Latz + Partner Landscape Architecture Urban Planning (Germany); TECNICA Y PROYECTOS S.A. (Spain); and MC2 ESTUDIO DE INGENIERIA S.L.U. (Spain). Their entry was selected for the large and accessible public spaces and how the buildings integrate into the urban context.



RESULTS OF THE ARCHITECTURAL COMPETITION IN TRIPOLI

MDDM (Lebanon) was awarded first prize in the International Architectural Design Competition for the Knowledge and Innovation Center in Tripoli, Lebanon. The entry was praised by the jury for its clear strategy that recalled some of Niemeyer's early designs, resonating with the rhythm of the grand canopy and in keeping with the language of the site.


