#### **RESULTS OF UIA-HYP CUP 2019**

Results are in for the 2019 edition of the UIA-HYP Cup, the Chinese international student architecture competition. The international jury, led by chair Benedetta Tagliabue, shortlisted 72 projects out of 877 submissions on the theme of "Happy Spaces – Integrating Architecture and Landscape". "Living in Fog", authored by Zhang Xiaoke, Liu Yaojia, Xin Zhiyuan and inspired by an ink painting by a painter of the Southern Song Dynasty depicting smoke and rain on the southern bank of the Yangtze River won First Prize. The winning team expressed their hope that architecture would help recreate the happy scene evoked in the painting.
